Brad M.	I'll sum up what I want to do, create an alumni community, that will allow us to gather their info, also allow other alum to view their info, and also allow alumni to go back in and login and update their info
Justin L.	I believe that they only work if you use path
Ian P.	Oh, wait... does that mean it won't have the appended #'s to keep caching working properly?
Ira42	Brad: Yes, and one of your custom weblog fields would also be a 'years' dropdown. When publishing an entry, select which year it belongs to. Then in your template, you basically do, " If logged in user selected 1988, show entries where 1988 field is chosen).
Sean S.	Ian probably not
Ian P.	So _that's_ why the idea hasn't been used more...
Ira42	Brad: Hard to explain here, but if you post to the EE forum, I can help with the details.
Brad M.	and I want to build this so it can be added to in the future.
Ian P.	FreshVariables to the rescue?
Casey R.	Brad: Do you need to restrict site content based on alumni year or just restrict members from viewing other members based on their year?

dashard	back to the dynamic variables in CSS: do I have to declare Globals or can I declare variables at the top of the Stylesheet?

Ian P.	You can declare them at the top, but then have to call the stylesheet in a special way... and that way apparently causes EE to not send the cache-control numbers at the end of the filename.
Jim W.	brad measure twice and cut once. you may need to try out a couple of scenarios to see what will leave you with a scalable platform.

Brad M.	well, i am not completely sure, but I know registered alum can at least view other alum of the same year, as far as others, I am unsure. is that possible?
dashard	Is that special way the "path=" ??
Sean S.	dashard – not sure as I just set up a couple of different paths using the template globabl variables and call them like this {images}/image.jpg etc...
Brad M.	also, can it be possible that I set up a form that allows an alum to email another alum without giving out their password. both alum's would be registered.
dashard	but where was {images} declared? Top of the sheet of Global?
Jim W.	Brad EE can do many things, half the gig is deciding what it is you want to do. the ole napkin sketch still works....
Casey R.	Brad: Jim has the right solution in that you probably just need to try a few scenarios to see what scales best. There are several approaches that could work depending on your specific needs
ErikReagan	dashard, I've done that while setting {images} in path.php
Brad M.	I know EE can do a ton, just making sure I am going about it the right way before I get knee deep.
Sean S.	cp where you make global variables – I believe it's on the template section
ErikReagan	as part of the \$global_vars array
Brad M.	I'll give it a try, I posted on solspace forum a few days ago and never heard back, think I'd be better off w/ just posting to EE forums?
Todd	Brad... I would create a custom member field called alumni_year. Then filter people by that. You could create a template for all people with currently logged in users alumni_year and a generic view all for other alumni years. Does that make sense?

Casey R.	Brad: I would recommend the User module though in any case.
ErikReagan	dashard, something like <code>\$global_vars = array("image_root"=>"/design/");</code>
Brad M.	Thanks Jim/Casey/Todd
Todd	yw
Sean S.	Erik, that might be more efficient than what I do... will look into that
Brad M.	another question, about BK's ff nGen filetype. on the CP edit side.
dashard	I know about the Globals. Just want to know where folks are declaring their variables for CSS. Is there a best practice? Does one impact performance over another? etc.
ErikReagan	dashard, I rarely declare variables for CSS
Brad M.	i have a custom field, using ff matrix nGen filetype.
ErikReagan	I typically store css as flat files on my server rather than EE templates
dashard	ErikReagan: That's in path.php, yes?
Brad M.	I went to pull up the edit form for one of the weblog entries that uses the nGen filetype and the page went blank.
Justin L.	dashard: yea

dashard	Gotcha, but for my ADD and memory issues, it would be a boon to remember some custom color *names* rather than try to recall the hex
Brad M.	so I had to jack it up from 156 mb in the htaccess file to 196mb
Casey R.	Brad: were there lots of other images already uploaded or larger ones
Brad M.	but the funny thing is...there was no file that was ever uploaded to that custom field in that entry.

Casey R.	seems like the "Choose Existing Image" option takes up lots of memory if there are lots to list
ErikReagan	dashard, create a commented area at the top of your CSS file with the values you use frequently
	then copy/paste when necessary
	one less template for EE to parse thus that much faster load time
dashard	Oh, Erik, that would be way too practical
Brad M.	where is the choose existing img option, under field upload dir prefs?
vik407	better than declare variables in css templates for dynamic content is using jquery an chang on the fly selector values... preventin caching files and reutilize ee native variables
ErikReagan	Brad, it's inline on the edit/publish pages where you upload the file
Justin L.	dashard I comment in the top area of the css tehn just doa find and replace when I need to change a value
dashard	Instead (to date) I created some text expansions that work with the custom color names I've given them

Then it transfers the file to the new server, and runs the migration script. Doesn't erase anything, anywhere. Took about 6 to 8 hours, coming from a 10GB site, with ~30 databases.

Todd	I wouldn't use find and replace... too risky... imho.
ErikReagan	Ira, I've never been locked out so I don't know
	how do people get locked out?
dashard	F/R would just be for image paths, etc that wound up hard-coded
ErikReagan	I mean, I screwed my first EE site up because I tried a find/replace straight in the DB
	and it screwed up serialization
dashard	lock out: change the path in all but one location
ErikReagan	then it told me my "user didn't exist"
Jim W.	I have edited those things directly in the db b4 (when things krapping out)
ErikReagan	it only tool doing that once to learn that lesson though
dashard	but if I actually stepped through a F/R and only changed image paths??
ErikReagan	tool = took*
Todd	I would just create a new template group called 'site' and copy the templates over. Then user apache rewrite to drop the site portion.
Ira42	Find / Replace has only ever worked for me using Mark Huot's "EE

	Migrator". Replaces and updates serialized arrays as well. Still use it!
ErikReagan	Ira, sounds similar to deploy helper
Todd	Check out HeidiSQL if you want to do some selective db changes.
Ira42	Erik: but it runs standalone, so you don't need to access it through CP. Does Deeploy do search / replace? Thought you had to go through one by one.
ErikReagan	deploy helper requires CP access and is one path at a time
